Retrofit Guide update Richard extended thanks to Nigel, Chris, Sarah and Bridget for collating the leaflets for delivery. The Retrofit Guide has been printed and will be delivered to households in the parish. As a result of the press release, news of the Retrofit Guide was published in the Cornish & Devon Post; by Cornwall Council in its Town and Parish Council newsletter; the RSN; and was also picked up by Radio Cornwall and Spotlight. Spotlight subsequently interviewed John Lewis, a local resident in the process of installing an air source pump, and Richard Davies. This has yet to be broadcast. All feedback received indicates that people are very impressed with the Retrofit Guide, and one BBC journalist said it was impressive that something like this had come out of a small parish council. <li data-bbox="252 1267 1489 1424"> 2. EV survey Cllr Davies has generated a survey on EVs. The consensus was to hold off distribution in the parish under the NDP is out of the way. January 5 is the official closing date for the NDP consultation, so the EV survey can be moved to the end of January. <li data-bbox="252 1458 1489 2085"> 3. Community events including possible Retrofit Guide event Susan said within the Old School News, there are many local events listed, so volunteers could attend these to talk to people about the Retrofit Guide. Some ideas included the pop-up café in the village hall; WI; U3A and the Repair Café. Nigel said if a standalone event was organized, the committee may be disappointed with the turnout. He said the committee could have a stall at the Old School Saturday market. Richard said there are also events outside the parish that they should attend. He is going to a Calstock event, and there is an event in Tavistock at which TEC has a stand. It would be useful if someone from the parish was there. It was felt to be important to maintain and increase the momentum. A question of charging for the guide was raised. A suggestion of £2 a copy was suggested. Richard has had some posters made up and printed, which are re-useable. Action – to identify events that can be attended in and out of the parish over the next six months. Reach out to any organisations like TEC to ask them, and also groups like the Round Table, WI and Rotary. Susan and Nigel will work on the list for the next meeting. Richard noted that TEC had said it would be a good idea to think of something else in the community. He suggested Community Energy. This will be placed on the next agenda.
