

# Stoke Climsland Parish Council – Carbon Net Zero

Report from the Carbon Net Zero Committee on progress of the Carbon Zero Homes Project.

The Committee met on Tuesday 11<sup>th</sup> July, following the interviews for the Community Energy Advisor post.

There were two short-listed candidates, both scoring well against the Person Specification. However, at the interview, it became apparent that one applicant was particularly suited to the role.

The recommendation to the Committee from the interviews was unanimous

The Committee have therefore instructed the Clerk to offer the post to Andrew Nevill, who many of you will already know.

Mr Nevill brought with him to the interview evidence of his deep interest in, and had already considered and researched the subject. We are lucky to have found such a talented scientific applicant for the post. He has had a long and distinguished career in health as a scientist, engineer and manager.

Mr Nevill responded promptly with an email accepting the post and confirming his ability to take up the appointment on Monday 17<sup>th</sup> July.
